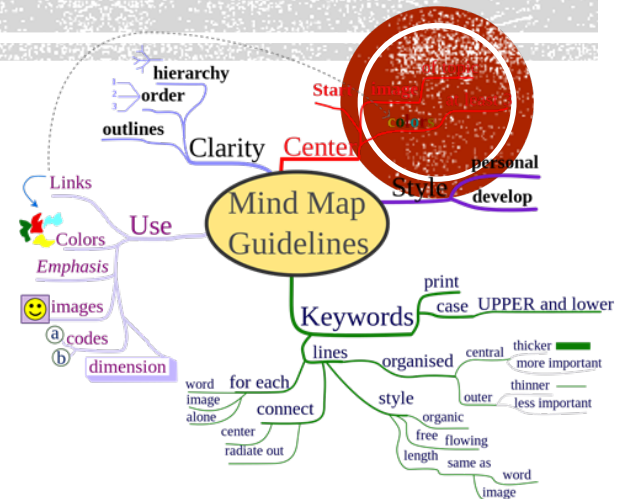

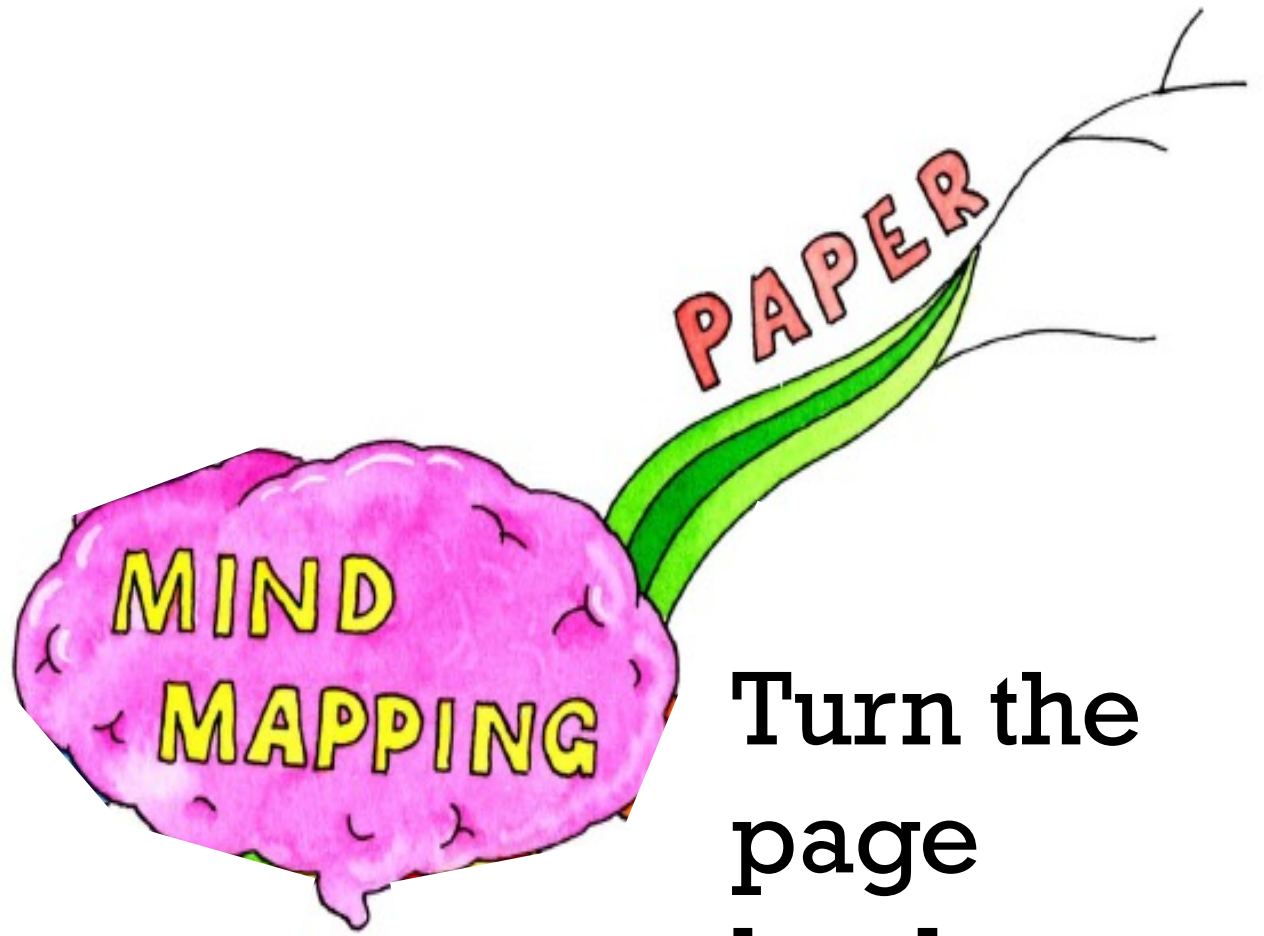

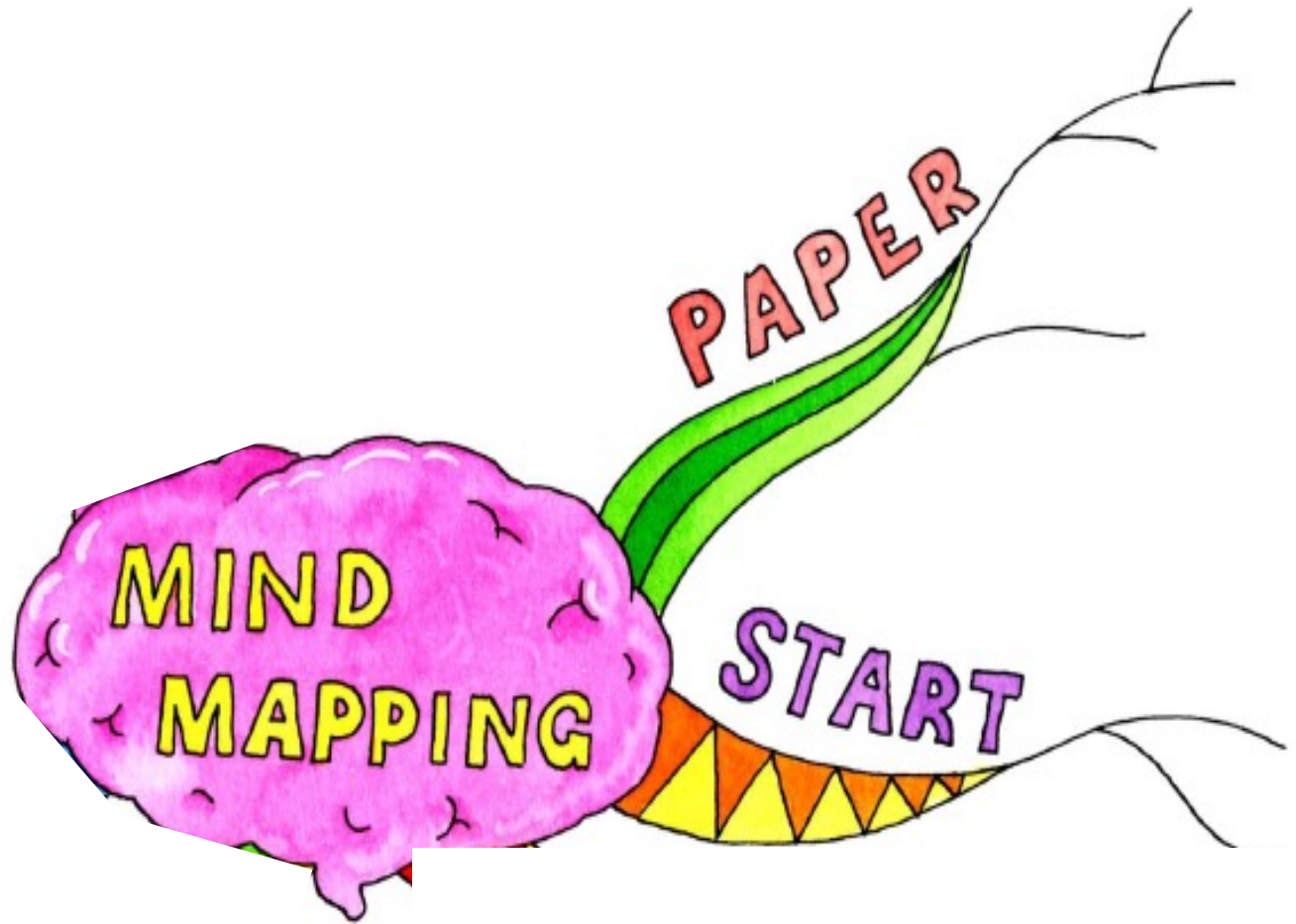


The six rules of mind mapping

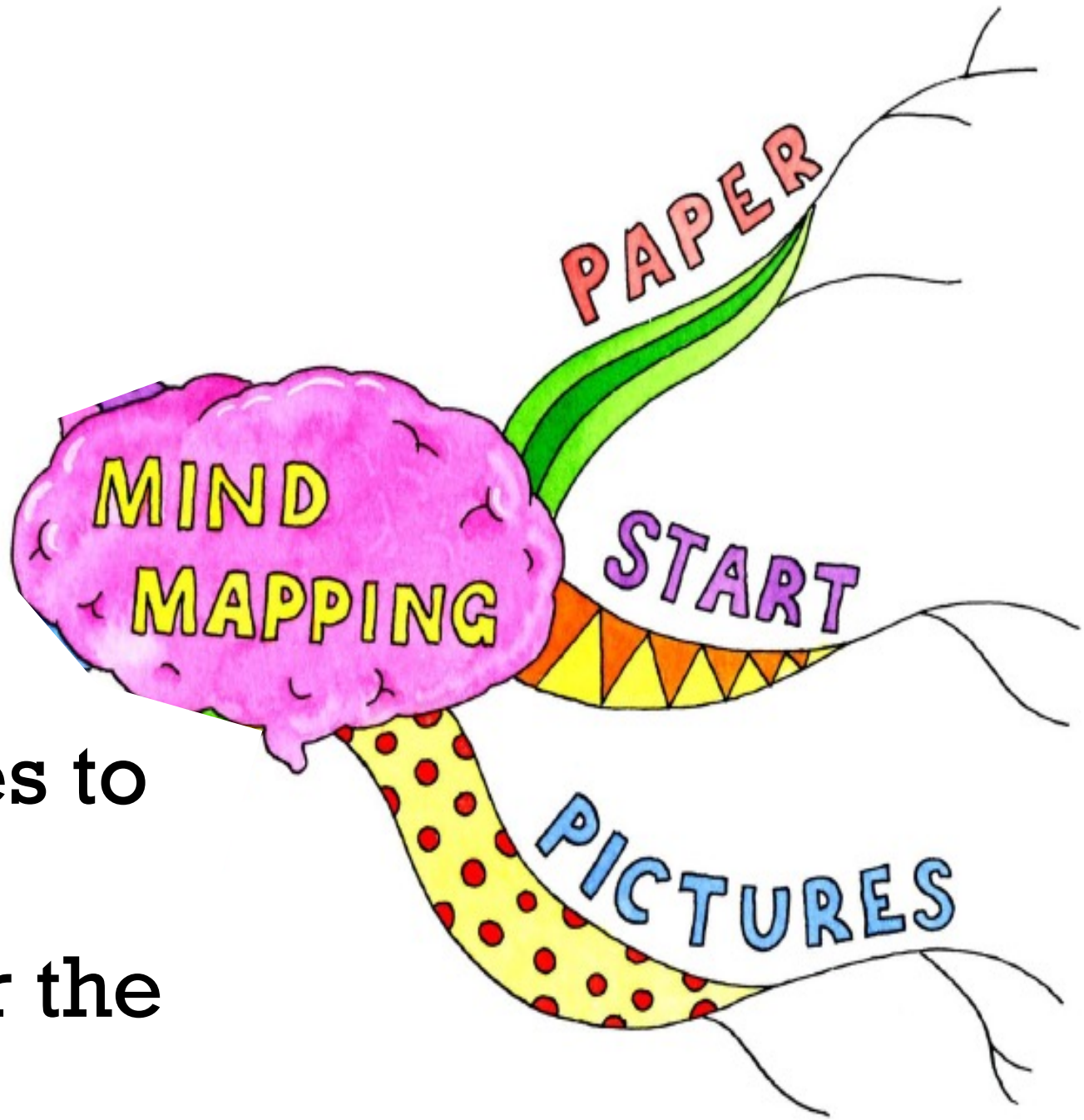




**Turn the

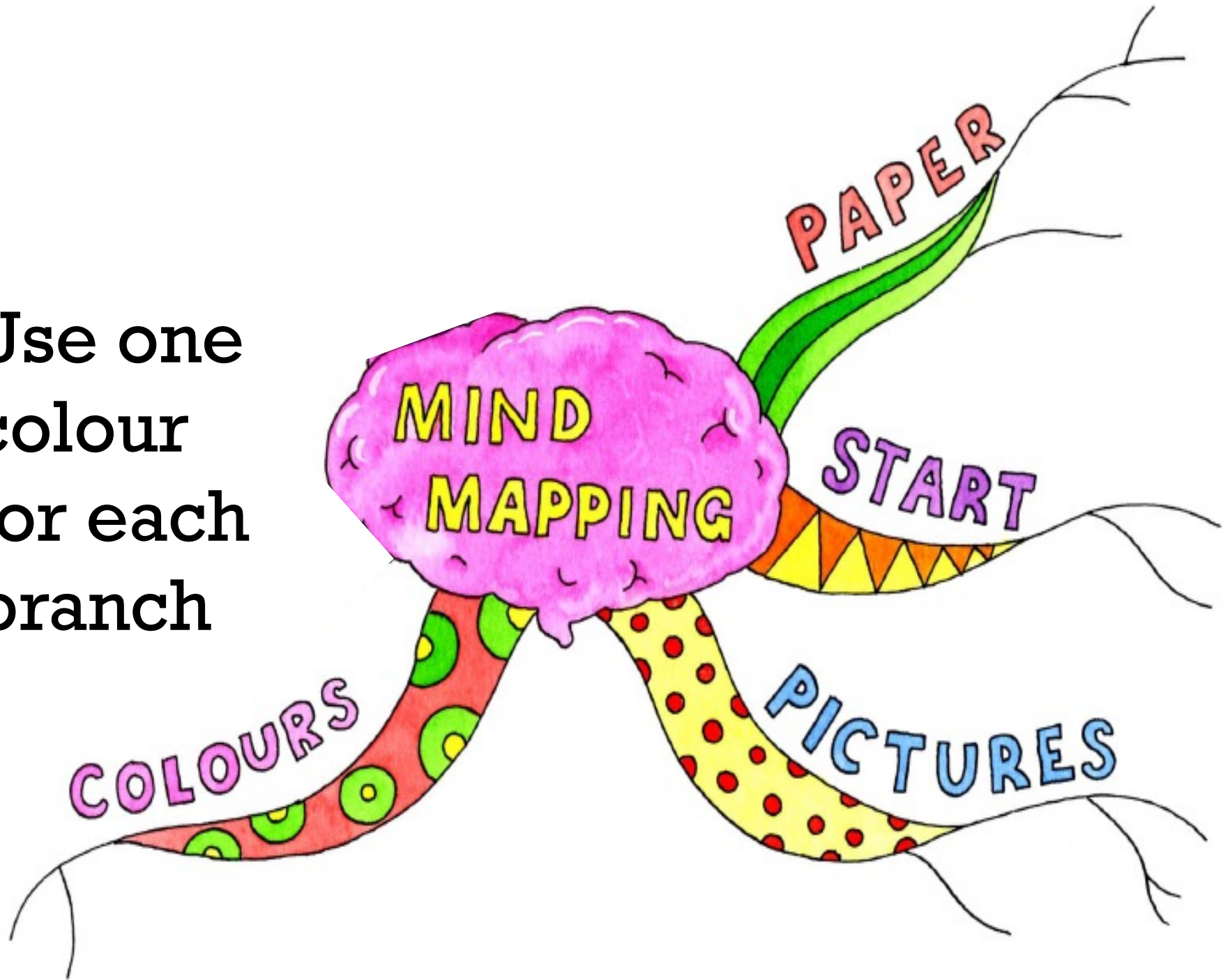


**Start in the centre &

for the branches**

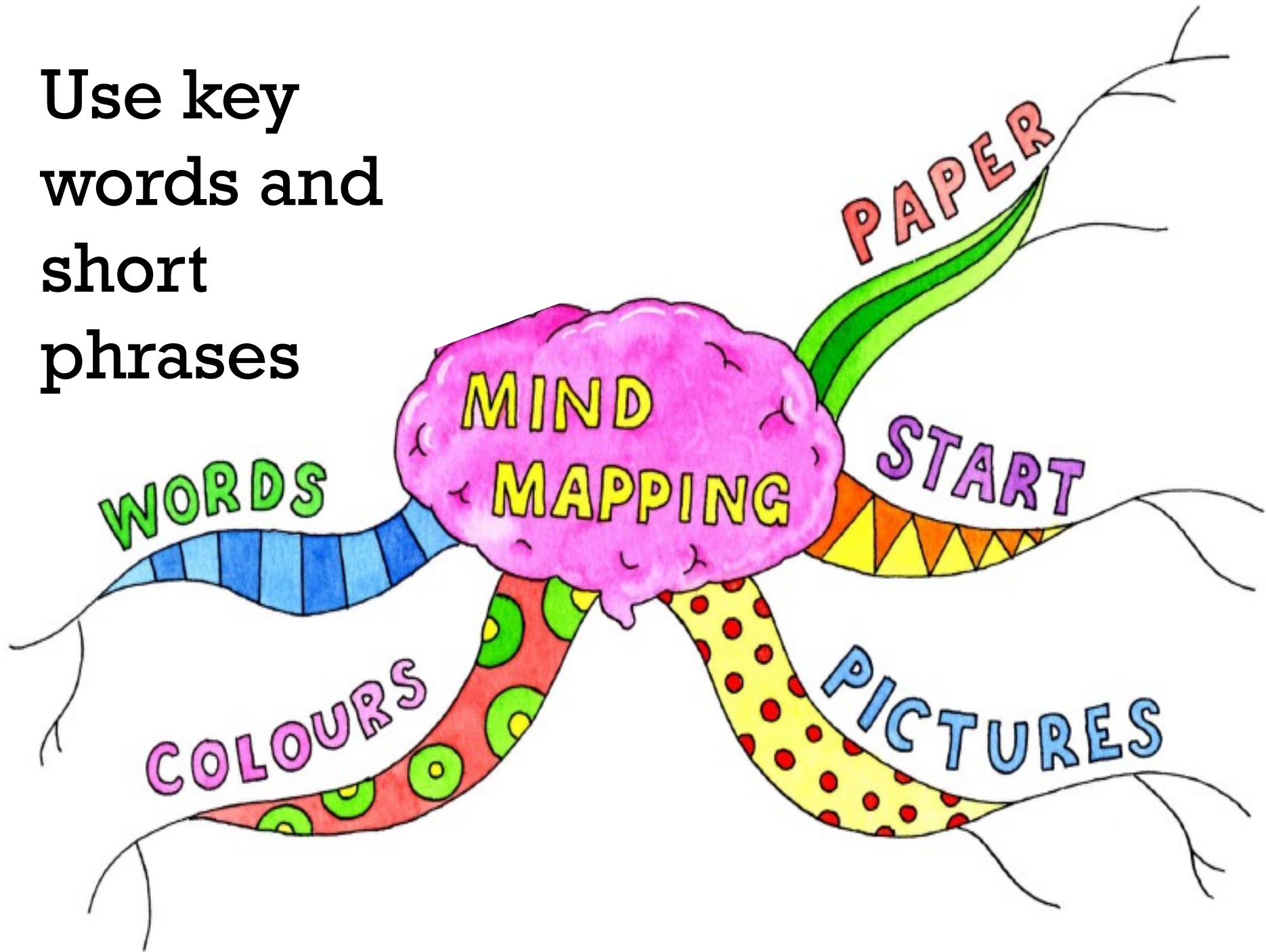


Use images to

content

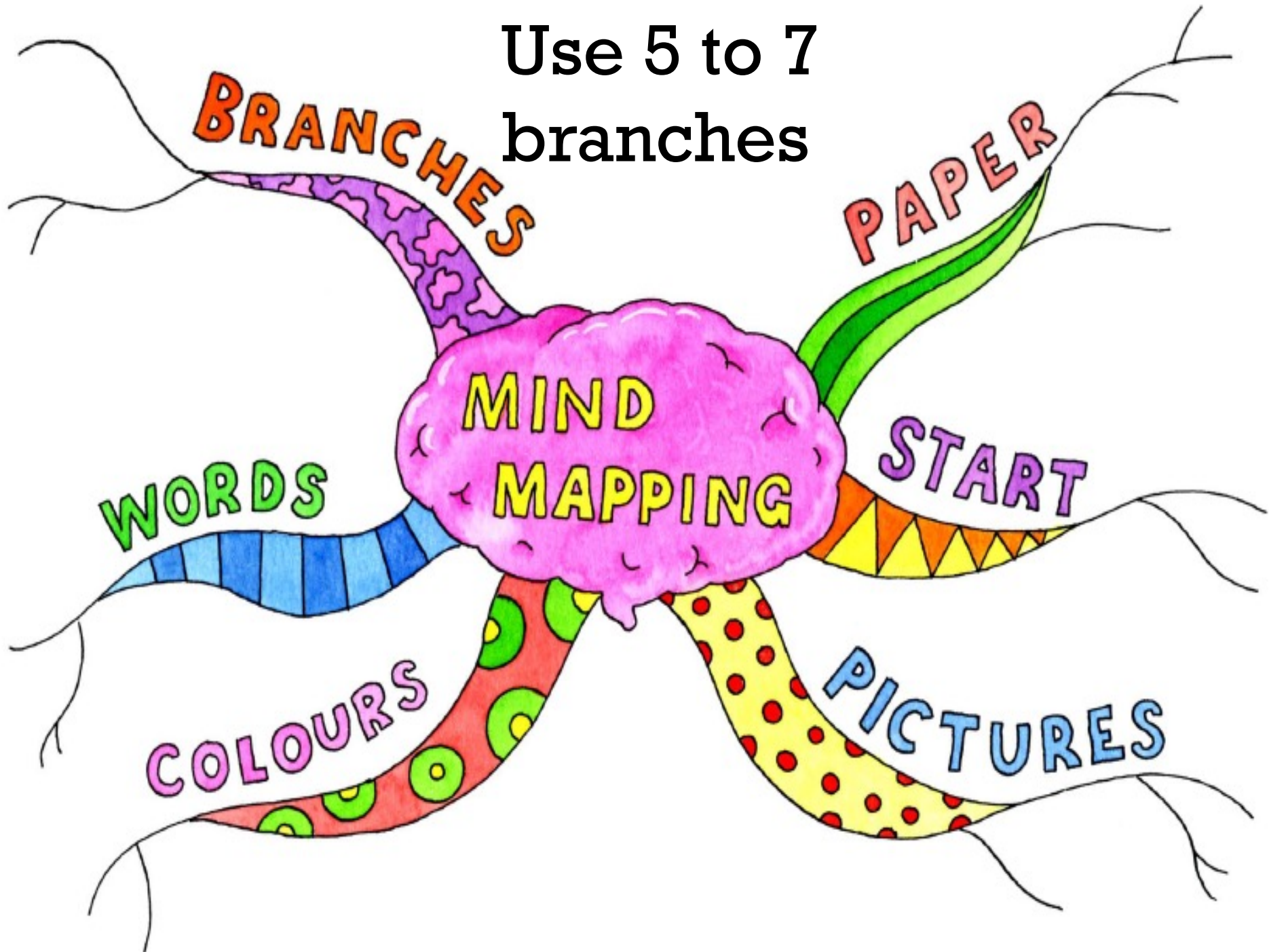
Use one
