

## What is special about the teenage brain?

- 1. The bridge between the left and right hemispheres matures.
- 2. Grey matter increases just before puberty.
- 3. There is a 17% reduction in this grey matter during puberty. (Pruning)
- 4. The pruning process can result in teenagers experiencing uncertainty and confusion.

#### **Emotional Recognition**



- Recognition of emotions in ourselves and others develops as we mature.
