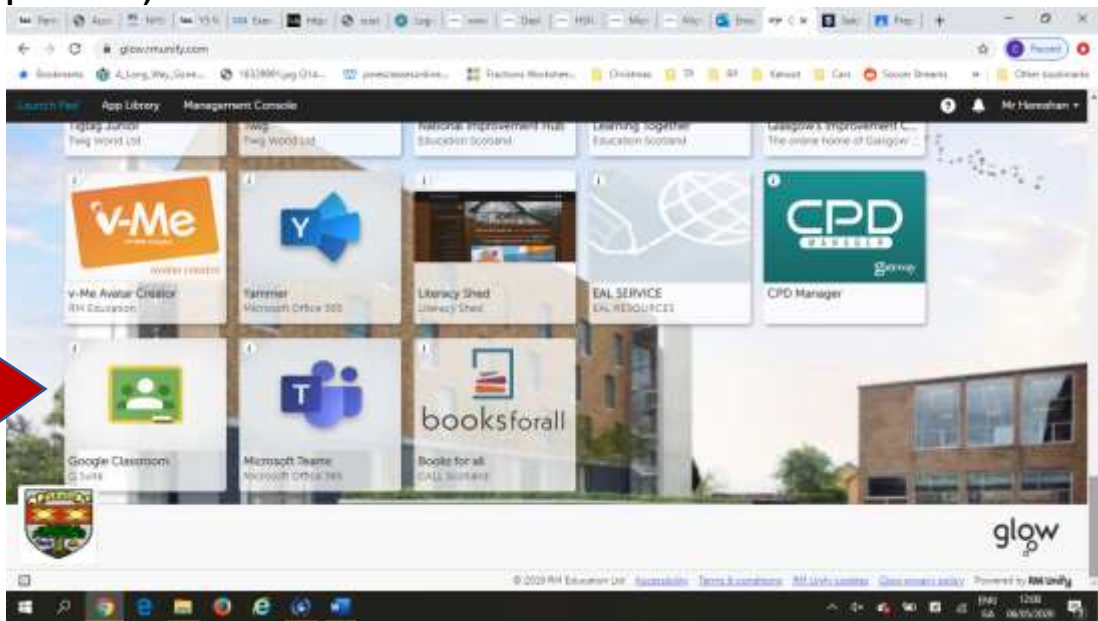

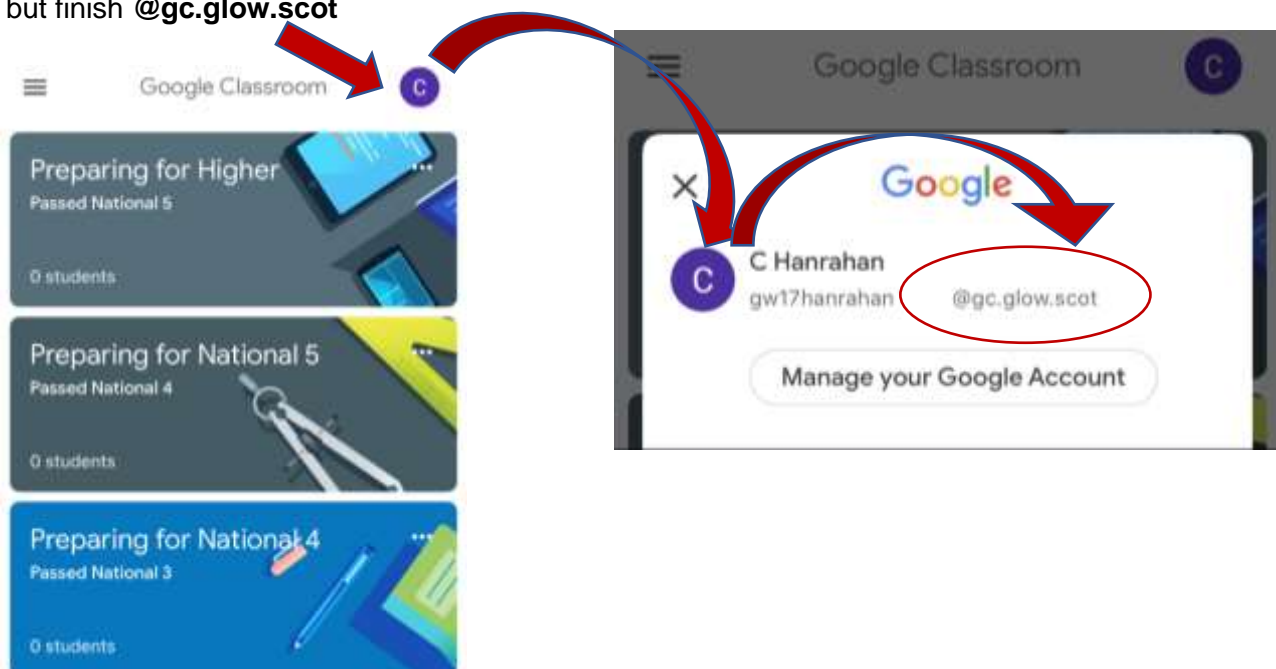

Using Google Classroom

- 1) If you're using a laptop or PC, sign into Glow using your Glow username and password and click on the Google Classroom tile which is normally at the bottom of the launchpad. **(Message me if you cannot remember your Glow name or password)**



- 2) If you are using your phone, download the Google classroom app first. Then sign into Glow using your internet browser and click on the Google Classroom tile and this should bring you into the app.
- 3) If that doesn't work, go to the app and make sure that your email is the correct email address and not your own personal Gmail account. It must start like your Glow email but finish **@gc.glow.scot**



- 4) Once you have accessed Google classroom, either on a PC or phone, joining a class is easy. All you must do know is hit the + button and type in the class code from the first page. This will automatically join you to your correct class.



- 5) Once you have joined the correct class you will be able to ask questions using the 'Stream'. You can see notes, worksheets and lessons in 'Classwork'. It is a good idea to turn Google Classroom notifications on if you are using a phone so you can see when the teacher gives work, or somebody answers a question.
