Child Protection and Safe-Guarding

- Mrs Seagrave is our CP and Safeguarding coordinator. Her role is to ensure that all young people are safe in school, at home and in the community. Mrs McNeil is the CP Officer.
- If staff have a Child Protection and Safeguarding concern about any young person in the school they must contact Mrs Seagrave to share it.








Child Protection and Safe-Guarding

- Your young person can speak with their Pastoral Care teacher in class during one of the 2 periods of Personal and Social Education.
- Tey can also make an appointment using QR codes which are located in classrooms and in corridor displays if they need a private conversation










Safe-Guarding and Attendance/Time-Keeping

- Your young person's attendance is monitored every period.
- Class teachers take a register within the first 10 minutes of the lesson.
- Texts are sent if your young person is not in class.
- Please encourage your young person to follow their timetable and be on time for all lessons.
- Glasgow City Council Target for attendance is 95%
- Please contact the school office if your young person will be absent.
- Pastoral Care staff will contact you by call or letter to discuss any concerns.
- Pupils with 95% attendance will have a certificate emailed to parent/carers at the end of this term.

5 min late per day/for class = 2 days lost learning

10 min late per day/for class = 4 days lost learning

15 min late per day/for class = 6 days lost learning

20 min late per day/for class = 8 days lost learning

30 min late per day/for class = 12 days lost learning







Mobile Phone Policy at KSS

NO PHONE ZONE

Our Policy and Expectations

Mobile phones will be switched off during class times
 Mobile phones will be placed in

bags or jackets

- Bags or jackets will be placed in an area of the classroom away from your learning space
- If you do not have a bag or jacket, mobile phones will be placed on the teacher's desk
- Any mobile phones/air pods which are seen in corridors/toilets during learning time will be placed in the school office by school staff to be collected at the end of the day

- Young people are asked to have mobile phone switched off during learning times.
- All phones should be placed in bags or jackets and in a designated area of each classroom.
- Pupils, staff and parent/carers were consulted on this last session.
- All agreed that failure to follow the KSS policy may result in phones being confiscated.
- The policy has been discussed in PSE lessons and assemblies.
- Please discuss this with your young person at home to support school being a NO PHONE ZONE.
